

**HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 345**  
**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

**The meeting will be held on Monday, October 16, 2023, at 12:00 Noon.**

The Board shall consider and/or act on following matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approve minutes of the September 18, 2023, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption of the District's 2023 tax rate;
4. Levy of the District's 2023 maintenance tax rate, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
5. Approval and execution of an Amendment to the Amended and Restated District Information Form;
6. Notification to residents regarding levy of the District's 2023 tax rate;
7. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
8. Status of compliance by the District with Texas Government Code, Chapter 2265, relative to energy reporting;
9. Annual review of Order Establishing Policy for Investment of District Funds and Appointing Investment Officer, and adoption of Resolution and amended Order in connection therewith;
10. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented and approve moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
11. Delinquent tax collections attorney report, and take any action in connection therewith, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
12. Engineer's Report, including:
  - (a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of a contract for the


- construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District and acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission ("TEC") Form 1295;
  - (b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval/and or concurrence of any pay estimates and change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, authorization to accept of TEC Form 1295, approval of any related storm water permits and approving of related storm water plans, including:
    - i. Installation of generators at the District's Lift Station Nos. 1 and 2 (CSE W-Industries, Inc.); and
    - ii. Installation of a generator at the District's Joint Wastewater Treatment Plant (CSE W-Industries, Inc.);
  - (c) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District;
  - (d) Approval of any consents to encroachment relative to District facilities;
  - (e) Discussion regarding the status of repairs to sidewalks and trails located within the District by Harris County Precinct 4 and Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 346; and
  - (f) Requirements for compliance with lead and copper rules for water systems, including lead service line inventory;
13. Status of acquisition of property owned by Second Baptist Church for a second water well; authorize any action in connection therewith;
14. Operator's Report, including:
- (a) Monthly Report;
  - (b) Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same;
  - (c) Appeals of District charges;
  - (d) Refer accounts for collection;
  - (e) Write-off of uncollectible accounts;
  - (f) Repair and maintenance of District facilities;
  - (g) Status of water meter replacement program;
  - (h) Implementation of Drought Contingency Plan; and
  - (i) Harris County Public Health Department's proposal for Wastewater-Based Epidemiology Program;
15. Status of testing District's water supply for arsenic levels;
16. Green Trails Monthly Report regarding supplemental law enforcement services;
17. Communication with District residents, including mass communication messaging system by Classic Messaging LLC; discuss options for potential District website;

18. Status of installation of a hike and bike underpass on Fry Road by Willow Fork Drainage District;
19. Attorney's Report;
20. Discuss status of potential litigation involving the District and authorize any action in connection therewith;
21. Convene Closed Session for consultation with attorney regarding pending or threatened litigation or matters protected by attorney-client privilege pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, as amended, and deliberation regarding the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property pursuant to Section 551.072, Texas Government Code, as amended;
22. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any actions related to matters discussed in Closed Session; and
23. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
