Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Monday, March 21, 2022, at 12:00 Noon.

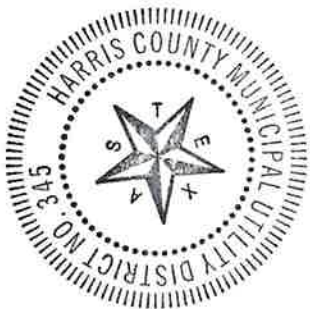
The Board shall consider and/or act on following matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approve minutes of the February 21, 2022, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
4. Ratification of prior action authorizing solicitation of bookkeeping proposals; consider proposals for bookkeeping services; consider approval of Second Amended and Restated Agreement for Bookkeeping Services between the District and Municipal Accounts & Consulting, L.P.; authorize any action in connection therewith;
5. Authorize consultants to research unclaimed property and consider authorizing Bookkeeper to prepare Unclaimed Property Report as of March 1, 2022;
6. Consider approval of agreement between the District and Classic Messaging for implementation of mass communication messaging system;
7. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented and approve moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
8. Delinquent tax collections attorney report, and take any action in connection therewith, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
9. Engineer's Report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of a contract for the construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District and acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission ("TEC") Form 1295, including:
 - i. Installation of generators at two (2) lift stations and the Joint Wastewater Treatment Plant or acquisition of a portable generator;
 - (b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval/and or concurrence of any pay estimates and change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, authorization to accept of TEC Form 1295, approval of


- any related storm water permits and approving of related storm water plans, including:
 - (c) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District;
 - (d) Approval of any consents to encroachment relative to District facilities; and
 - (e) Discussion regarding Capital Reserve Study and Five Year Capital Improvement Plan for District facilities;
- 10. Consider amendment to operating budget for District's fiscal year ending January 31, 2023;
- 11. Discussion of possible acquisition of property owned by Second Baptist Church for a second water well; authorize any action in connection therewith;
- 12. Operator's Report, including:
 - (a) Monthly Report;
 - (b) Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements, including review of any notices of violations, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as and if required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same;
 - (c) Appeals of District charges;
 - (d) Refer accounts for collection;
 - (e) Write-off of uncollectible accounts;
 - (f) Repair and maintenance of District facilities;
 - (g) Status of water meter replacement program; and
 - (h) Authorize annual submission to each electric utility that provides transmission and distribution service to the District and each retail electric provider for determination of District facilities that qualify for critical load status relative to compliance with Section 13.1396, Texas Water Code;
- 13. Green Trails Monthly Report regarding supplemental law enforcement services;
- 14. Status of Green Trails Municipal Utility District ("Green Trails MUD") request to purchase water from the District while Green Trails MUD recoats its ground storage tank; and authorize any action in connection therewith;
- 15. Consider an amendment to the Emergency and Interim Water Supply Contract between the District and (i) Green Trails Municipal Utility District, and (ii) West Park Municipal Utility District, and authorize any action in connection therewith;
- 16. Status of Interlocal Agreement between the District and Willow Fork Drainage District in connection with the installation of a hike and bike underpass on Fry Road;
- 17. Attorney's Report;

18. Supplemental Agenda in English, Spanish, Vietnamese and Chinese: Consider adoption of Order Declaring Candidates Elected;
19. Convene Closed Session for consultation with attorney regarding matters protected by attorney-client privilege pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, as amended, and deliberation regarding the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property pursuant to Section 551.072, Texas Government Code, as amended;
20. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any actions related to matters discussed in Closed Session; and
21. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
